## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Abstract Dot on Gradient Dotted Stripe - White (A), cut:

- See instructions to cut (1) Arabesque template.

From the Multi-sized Medallion on Black Ground -
Black/Red (B), cut:

- See instructions to cut (3) Arabesque templates.

From the Gray Ground with Abstract Motif - Gray (C), cut:

- See instructions to cut (3) Arabesque templates.

From the Funky Flowers on Stripe Patchwork Red/Black (D), cut:

- See instructions to cut (10) Arabesque templates.

From the Lantern Shaped Tiles - Multi (E), cut:

- See instructions to cut (7) Arabesque templates.


## From the Red Medallion on Black Ground -

 Black/Red (F), cut:- See instructions to cut (7) Arabesque templates.

From the Geometric Triangles on Stripe - Red/Black (G), cut:

- See instructions to cut (9) Arabesque templates.

From the Red Small Flower with Black Trellis -
Red/Black (H), cut:

- See instructions to cut (9) Arabesque templates.

From the Red Ground with Black Scroll - Red (I), cut:

- (8) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.
- See instructions to cut (11) Arabesque templates.

From the Trumpet Flowers on Red Ground - Red (J), cut:

- See instructions to cut (11) Arabesque templates.

From the Black Ground with Gray Scroll - Black (K), cut:
-(4) $51 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $51 / 2 " \times 711 / 4 "$ strips.

- (4) $51 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $51 / 2 " \times 753 / 4 "$ strips.

From the White on White Set Dot - White (L), cut:
-(2) $653 / 4 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to $653 / 4 " \times 711 / 4 "$ rectangle.

## From the Patchwork Stripe Blocks - Black/White

 (Backing), cut:- (2) 89 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $84 " \mathrm{x} 89 "$ back.


## Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

1. Sew (1) $51 / 2 " \times 711 / 4 "$ Fabric K strip to each side of the $653 / 4 " \times 711 / 4 "$ Fabric L rectangle. Sew (1) $51 / 2 " \times 753 / 4 "$ Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric L rectangle to make the Center Block.

## MOROCCAN RED <br> Quilt 2

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2. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about $1 / 8$ " outside the drawn lines.
3. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
4. Refer to the quilt layout to arrange and press the (71) assorted Arabesques onto the Center Block.
5. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make the quilt top.
6. Layer and quilt as desired.
7. Sew the (8) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric I strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
8. Bind as desired.
